

State CIF Infraction / School Sanctions

Creation of CIF rules and regulations, developed and approved by member schools which all schools pledge to observe, began in 1914. This decision established an enforcement program designed to be a cooperative undertaking involving schools, leagues, sections and the State CIF working together for an improved administration of education based interscholastic athletics.

Current State CIF Sanctions

Sanction:

- 1) 2 year prohibition (2010 & 2011) from State CIF So Cal Boys' Volleyball Championships should they qualify. The two-year prohibition may be reduced to one year if by September 1, 2009, SHHS administration submits a satisfactory written plan to ensure another occurrence of this type does not happen again.
- 2) Two year probation (August 1, 2009-June 30, 2010) for all athletic programs at Sage Hill High School. Any infraction during this time of any CIF Southern Section and/or State rules or regulations shall result in further sanction that may include suspension of membership.
- 3) Due to a lack of administrative oversight, all administrators of SHHS must attend an athletic administrators training provided by the State CIF and paid for by SHHS.
